They discussed the ways in which the school ensured that they met the academic needs of all pupils and how they identified and supported children who had additional learning and personal needs.

Mrs Sims outlined a range of strategies including Inclusion Hub workshops, peer tutors, sentence stem support and the Forest School workshops last term to develop learning behaviours such as resilience, independence and listening, which had very positive feedback from staff, children and parents.

They also discussed how the school supports children in their spiritual development. Rev. David has been supporting staff in developing their confidence and understanding of spirituality and will be visiting the school for another RE learning walk later in the term.

Suggestions were made about how the "Random Acts of Kindness" could be sustained and developed this year and community projects the school might be able to get involved with.
