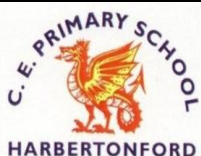


Pupil Premium Data 2016-2017

After careful consideration of evidence and or own school priorities, last year, (during 2015/2016) we spent the money on:

- Continued provision for vulnerable children to have access to "Thrive Support Sessions."
- Develop extra-curricular opportunities, targeting the needs of pupil premium children
- Provide regular forest school enrichment
- Source further resources to support pupils in closing the gaps
- Increased support for children who are working below age related expectations. Some to have additional 1:1 or small group teaching time.
- TA training for behaviour support
- Additional classroom support is provided for children working below age related expectations.
- Ensure milk continues to be available for all

Outcomes to date – Progress of Pupil Premium Pupils 2015/2016 (July 16)

Reading: 47% at ARE, 7% above ARE, 47% below ARE
 Writing: 40% at ARE, 0% above ARE, 60 % below ARE
 Maths: 33% at ARE, 7% above ARE, 60% below ARE

Planned Spending and Actions for this year, 2016/2017

- Additional TA support for vulnerable children to have continued access to Thrive Support Sessions.
- Subsidise extra-curricular activities including trips and residential visits to support pupil premium children accessing all opportunities provided
- Forest School – trained Forest School Leader led sessions
- TA Thrive training – Fear and Anger
- TA training for Precision Teaching and Speech-Link
- Support for pupils working below ARE in Precision teaching and Speechlink.
- Ensure milk continues to be available for all
